## Internationalisation and intercultural exchange at the Protestant University of Applied Sciences Freiburg“ fund

### **Funding for research projects, events and publications**

Internationality and therefore exchange with partner universities and stakeholders from around the world is a central concern for the Protestant University of Applied Sciences Freiburg (EH Freiburg). The internationalisation strategy shows that international relations and intercultural exchange must be strengthened and expanded.

The Wilhelm Frank Foundation, whose goal includes the promotion of intercultural understanding and exchange, makes available resources to the university for the „Internationalisation and intercultural exchange at the Protestant University of Applied Sciences Freiburg“ fund. The resources will benefit the strengthening of internationalisation at the EH Freiburg. They will allow the initiation and support of research projects, events and other activities that benefit intercultural exchange.

One area of funding aims for the development of the content and integration of international perspectives of the various EH projects. This area of funding is particularly aimed at project initiatives of or in cooperation with the social work faculty and the peace institute of the EH Freiburg.

## Funding is provided in particular for:

- Publications on international issues and topics. European and international partners are welcome to apply. Funding may be considered in other cases.
- Lectures, symposia and similar events on European and international topics at the university or lectures planned at another location in cooperation with the university.
- Support of third-party funding applications with international research partners.
- Short-term support for incoming students who are experiencing financial hardship and no other funding options are available or those requiring support until other funding becomes available.

All funding options are intended to support projects that cannot be funded by the EH Freiburg. Access to all funding opportunities should be low-threshold.

Applications together with an informative statement of reasons can be submitted to the International Office at any time. In addition to basic information about the project, the statement should describe the project’s relevance to international exchange and the reason why funding is required.

Grants of varying amounts can be applied for. However, an individual grant should not exceed €2,000. The amount can be higher in justified exceptional cases only.
